  - Begin to draft recommendations around Choice and Enrollment.

## Overview

### Meeting Topic

All three subcommittees refined definitions of their charge and clarified their roles within the [Superintendent's Transition Process](#). They also focused on narrowing in on the top priorities that they will want to dive deeper into in preparation for the final recommendations that will shape the next multi-year strategic plan. The teams also mapped out their plans for the rest of the Transition Advisory Team meetings to help guide the process as they approach the last few meetings before wrapping up in December.

### Emerging Themes

#### *Student Experience and Achievement:*

Confirmed areas of study:

- Responsiveness to student needs and student voice
- Family engagement to support student learning
- Teacher/leader/educator support

#### *Equity and Excellence:*

Broad agreement exists on the proposed idea of establishing an equity rubric to be applied to all aspects of the strategic planning process as well as the implementation of the strategic plan. However, the group briefly discussed if that should actually be a foundational guideline opposed to a named priority.

#### *Operational Effectiveness:*

- The lens of equity and access in informing the priority/recommendation around Transportation was ranked the highest by the sub-committee
- The subcommittee has begun the work to outline the Transportation priority statement based on the large group dialogue

### Remaining Questions

- Equity remains top of mind in all three subcommittees, and discussion continues around ensuring alignment across each team's focus
- Teams are considering processes for confirming their priorities and working together most effectively in a short amount of time
